## **Community Passover Food Drive April 1-12**

MILWAUKEE, Wisconsin— Food donations for the Community Passover Food Drive (Ma'ot Chittim) will be collected April 1-12 at several collection sites, including the Milwaukee Jewish Federation and the Harry and Rose Samson Family Jewish Community Center.

Products needed, which must have kosher certification for Passover: matzo, gefilte fish (cans preferred), chicken soup/matzo ball mix and 22 oz. grape juice. These basic items will then be supplemented with additional traditional Passover items. In 2015, the drive was able to serve 600 individuals and families.

Volunteers are needed, and families are welcome, on April 17 from 9-11 a.m. or 10:45 a.m. – 12:45 p.m. to sort and distribute food.
